CRISIS MANAGEMENT PLAN:

Every academy/school is required to have a Crisis Management Plan. A template is provided through the Diocese on how to plan for various emergencies. Parents will be notified through Option C (email and text) if there has been a crisis and what steps were taken to respond to the crisis. So it is important to make sure the school office has you most recent contact information at all times. Some things you needs to know are:

1. Lock down procedures are in place and we practice the procedure 4 times throughout the academic year.
2. In the need for an internal evacuation of classrooms - teachers lead their students to the auditorium using the same route as a Fire Drill.
3. Out of school building evacuation - teachers lead their students to St. Francis of Assisi Church existing the building using the same route as a Fire Drill. (If entrance to Church is not available, we evacuate to the Parish Center)
